- "Since our last report this summer...", many good things have happened at Canal Shores!
- Repairs are underway all around the course, including the bridge, Pro Shop, old starter shack and fencing. Upgrades continue to the greens, fairways and areas bordering the canal. We also have been able to get new or upgrade and repair equipment to help make the grounds look their best. All this progress is due to the generosity of neighbors and local businesses that have sponsored holes or supported us to make these improvements possible.
- Old brush and invasive species are being cleared, making the course a welcoming natural habitat. With new partnerships with the Talking Farm, TreeKeepers and Audubon International program, Canal Shores is moving towards becoming an Audubon Cooperative Sanctuary. The pro bono help of Steve Neumann and Logic Lawn Care has been huge.
- The berm at the 6th hole (near Sheridan Road at Gillson Park) has been rebuilt. Generous neighbors helped plan and execute the effort.
- Doggy bag dispensers with biodegradable doggy bags have been installed on selected holes to help in keeping the course clean and walkable.
